



Yarkhill Village Hall

Built in the second half of the 19th Century, Yarkhill Village Hall was once the village school. When this was closed in 1970, the Parish Council converted the building to a village hall for the people of the parish.

Managed by the Village Hall Committee, all members of the Parish, the building is a great venue for meetings, parties, bowling and other events.

A typical Victorian building, the Village Hall is maintained and has recently been greatly improved by the committee. It features three rooms which serve multiple purposes, plus a fully functioning and well equipped kitchen. The Hall is available to hire year round at very reasonable cost.

The committee also has a skittle alley and scaffolding for hire, as well as tables and chairs for events. See prices below.

Situated west from the A4103 road (Hereford to Worcester), the car park has a milk vending machine that is operated by Showle Dairy from 6am to 9pm.
